a) Women Empowerment:

- i. New Aajivika Self Help Group: Company supports this self-sustained model for women to earn their livelihood by making & selling of organic sweets and jams. The products made by them have won several accolades at both State and National level. Company had provided them equipment and tools to enable them enhance the products output and marketing.
- **ii.** The Company under the CSR plan is also taking various initiatives to empower women. Around the Project site local women are trained for sewing, tailoring etc. for their capacity building.

b) Education:
